

DEACON NOMINATION FORM

Instructions: Calvary members are invited to nominate men from our church family to be considered for the ministry of Deacon. Men who meet the Biblical qualifications for Deacon and have been a Calvary member for at least one year may be nominated. Deacon nominations should be made on this form and turned into the Nominating Committee no later than Sunday, Sept. 12th, by placing them in the offering plate or by mailing or giving them to our Church Administrator Howard Parker. Our church bylaws set forth a careful process whereby the names of those nominated will be considered for this ministry. The Nominating Committee will recommend persons for election to the Deacon body at the November business conference.

Biblical Qualifications for Deacons: (I Timothy 3:8-13) *“Likewise deacons must be reverent, not double-tongued, not given to much wine, not greedy for money, holding the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience. But let these also first be tested; then let them serve as deacons, being found blameless. Likewise, their wives must be reverent, not slanderers, temperate, faithful in all things. Let deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well. For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a good standing and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.”*
